Fortunately, for thousands of homeless men and women in Chicago, The Boulevard provides shelter and care, so the homeless can fully recover from illness or injury.

Background:

The Boulevard is Illinois' first and only medical respite center for the homeless, serving over 8,000 men and women for over 20 years in a 64-bed facility. Absent The Boulevard's services, individuals usually have longer hospital stays, and more readmissions and emergency room visits. Having a safe supportive environment is critical to healing, decreasing costs, and improving each patient's quality of life.

Mission:

To provide a healing environment and resources to help ill and injured homeless adults restore their health, rebuild their lives, and regain self-sufficiency.

What We Do:

Upon arrival, The Boulevard offers residents interim housing as well as access to programs and medical services not available at a traditional shelter.

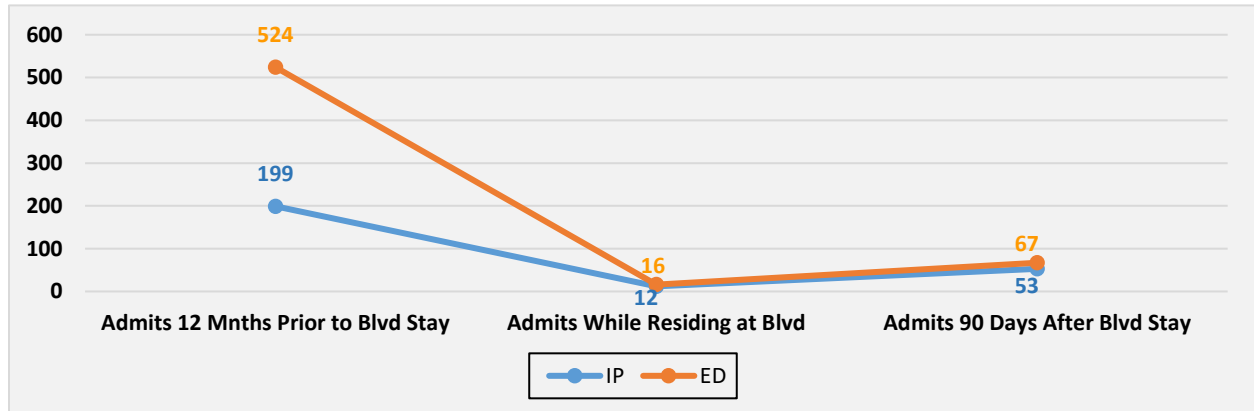
- **Physical Health** – Each resident works with the physician and nursing staff from PCC Wellness in the on-site clinic to implement his or her individualized care plan, and eventual discharge plan.
- **Behavioral Health** – For residents who have mental health or substance abuse issues, on-site treatment, group sessions and one-on-one counseling, are provided.
- **Coaching** – To assist residents on the path to self-sufficiency, The Boulevard enrolls residents in the appropriate benefit programs and provides a variety of life skills classes.
- **Employment Assistance** – Based on health severity, residents can engage in the Alvin Baum Employment Project to build on their own experience and access resources for greater independence.

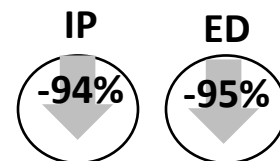
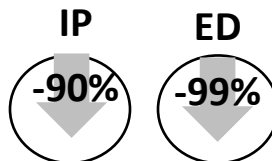
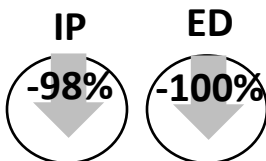
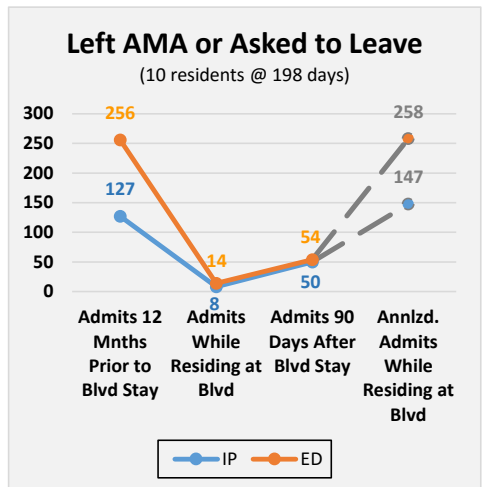
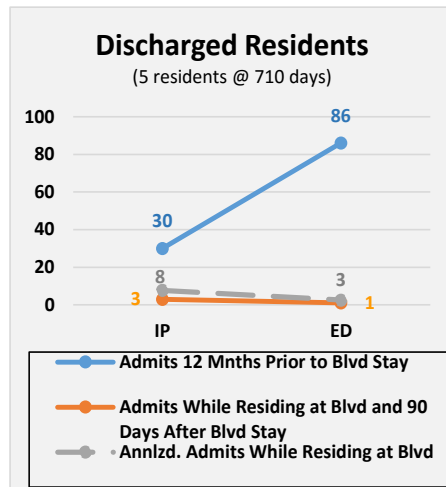
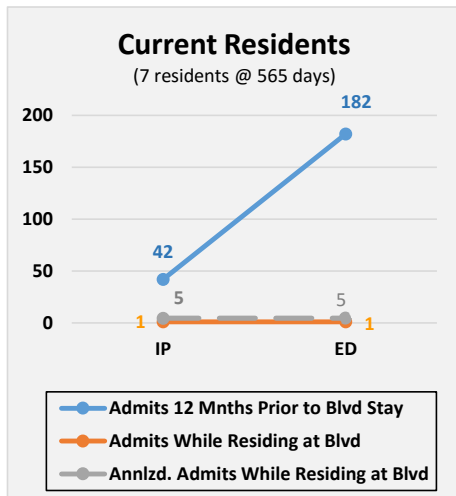
Program Results: IlliniCare Savings
